Annual Scholarship Process

Finding the Scholarship Site:

- Visit the SCC Foundation scholarship site at <https://www.shoreline.edu/foundation/scholarships.aspx> . Here you will find the link for the scholarship site in the top green box or you can look through the list of Annual Scholarships. The list will provide you with information on which scholarships are available to apply for.

Creating a Login:

- All applicants will need to use their go.shoreline.edu email address to setup an account. If you have not completed the Admissions form and received your email; please visit <https://www.public.ctc.edu/ApplicantWebClient/Applicant/ApplyWelcome.aspx> . Follow the instructions to apply for admission to Shoreline Community College. You will receive access to your email from Shoreline Technical Services within 48 hours. Once you receive your email you may apply for Scholarships.

Application Process:

1. All applicants must complete the General Application “2017 - 2018 Shoreline Community College Foundation Scholarship Application”. This application collects the applicant’s general information and is required for all scholarships.

You must complete the two items below in the General Application. Failure to do so will disqualify you from consideration. Please see A and B below for more information.

- a. Within in the general application you must submit a copy of your SCC unofficial transcript if you are a current Shoreline Community College Student. Please use your SCC login credentials and login <https://www.shoreline.edu/apply-and-aid/registration/unofficial-transcripts.aspx> to access your unofficial transcript.
 - b. All applicants must complete the budget worksheet. Please complete this form <https://shoreline.scholarships.ngwebsolutions.com/cimages/shoreline/USE%20-%20BUDGETWORKSHEET-fillable%20-%20add%20into%20apps%20separately.pdf> (link is also included in the application). You will need to complete this worksheet to the best of your abilities/estimates are allowed. You will need to save a copy to your computer and then upload the file into the Financial Information Section.
2. Once you have completed the General Application “2017 - 2018 Shoreline Community College Foundation Scholarship Application” please acknowledge and submit this form. This form does

not mean you have applied for a scholarship. Once you have completed this portion you will be provided the list of scholarships that you will need to apply for separately.

3. Please click “Start Application” on the scholarships you would like to apply for. You will need to complete any of the additional requested information that each individual scholarship requires.
4. Once you have completed the application and wish to submit it you will need to click “Next”. You will then see a blue “submit application” button and a copy of your application for review. Please make sure everything is complete and correct before you click the blue “Submit Application” button.
5. Uncompleted applications can be found in your task manager. You may save and reopen your application as many times as you need as long as the application has not been submitted. Please make sure that all applications are submitted by March 31, 2017.
6. You can search for scholarships using the “Scholarship Search” on the upper menu bar. This feature will allow you to browse and review criteria for applying.
