## Shoreline Community College New International Student Scholarship

The Shoreline Community College Foundation will offer \$1,000 and \$500 individual scholarships to new F-1 full-time students who have been admitted to the College in fall, winter, and spring quarters. Applicants should demonstrate academic excellence, personal success, and contribution to the community.

*Scholarships will be applied toward SCC tuition and fees for the starting quarter. These scholarships have no cash exchange value and will be non-transferable to any other quarters or other institutions.*

### Criteria for Eligibility

- ❖ Applicant must have been accepted to Shoreline Community College as an F-1 student
- ❖ Applicant must enroll full time (minimum of 12 credits) to receive the scholarship in their first quarter
- ❖ Applicant must provide evidence of high academic achievement in their most recent year of school
- ❖ Applicant must demonstrate evidence of extra-curricular activities, accomplishments, and/or service
- ❖ Applicant must **not** have previously attended any college in the United States
- ❖ Transfer students from another college or university are **not** eligible

### Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit the following documents:

1. Completed application
2. Academic transcripts from secondary or post-secondary schools in English
3. A list of extra-curricular activities, including accomplishments, school awards, and/or community service activities (most recent listed first)
4. One page essay describing your personal, professional, and academic goals

### Application Procedures:

To be considered, each applicant must submit all documents by the deadline prior to their first quarter of attendance at Shoreline Community College as listed below. Documents should be submitted to [ischolarship@shoreline.edu](mailto:ischolarship@shoreline.edu) with the subject line of **New International Student Scholarship**.
