Shoreline Community College New International Student Scholarship

The Shoreline Community College Foundation will offer \$1,000 and \$500 individual scholarships to new F-1 full-time students who have been admitted to the College in fall, winter, and spring quarters. Applicants should demonstrate academic excellence, personal success, and contribution to the community.

Scholarships will be applied toward SCC tuition and fees for the starting quarter. These scholarships have no cash exchange value and will be non-transferable to any other quarters or other institutions.

Criteria for Eligibility

- ❖ Applicant must have been accepted to Shoreline Community College as an F-1 student
- ❖ Applicant must enroll full time (minimum of 12 credits) to receive the scholarship in their first quarter
- ❖ Applicant must provide evidence of high academic achievement in their most recent year of school
- ❖ Applicant must demonstrate evidence of extra-curricular activities, accomplishments, and/or service
- ❖ Applicant must **not** have previously attended any college in the United States
- ❖ Transfer students from another college or university are **not** eligible

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit the following documents:

1. Completed application
2. Academic transcripts from secondary or post-secondary schools in English
3. A list of extra-curricular activities, including accomplishments, school awards, and/or community service activities (most recent listed first)
4. One page essay describing your personal, professional, and academic goals

Application Procedures:

To be considered, each applicant must submit all documents by the deadline prior to their first quarter of attendance at Shoreline Community College as listed below. Documents should be submitted to ischolarship@shoreline.edu with the subject line of **New International Student Scholarship**.
